## ADOBE PHOTOSHOP & ADOBE INDESIGN GUIDELINES FOR REPLICATING COLORS ON SFNM PRESSES

The following steps will enable more consistent color reproduction on the KBA Comet coldset printing press, which was SNAP certified in 2009. SNAP stands for Specifications for Newsprint Advertising Production. Visit **SNAPQUALITY.COM** for more information.

You will need the following files to begin:  
(both have been supplied to you in an email)

**SNAP 2009.icc**

**SFNM.joboptions**

**PC SNAP 2009.icc install:** place the file in the following location:

C:\ProgramFiles\CommonFiles\Adobe\Color\Profiles\Recommended

**MAC SNAP 2009.icc install:** place the file in the following location:

Macintosh HD\Library\Colorsync\Profiles\Profiles\Recommended

**NOTE:** In order for Adobe apps to see this profile, they must be restarted.

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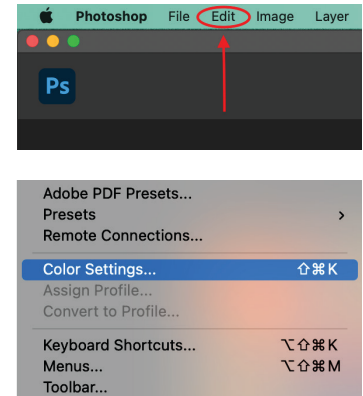
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# ADOBE PHOTOSHOP APPLICATION SETTINGS

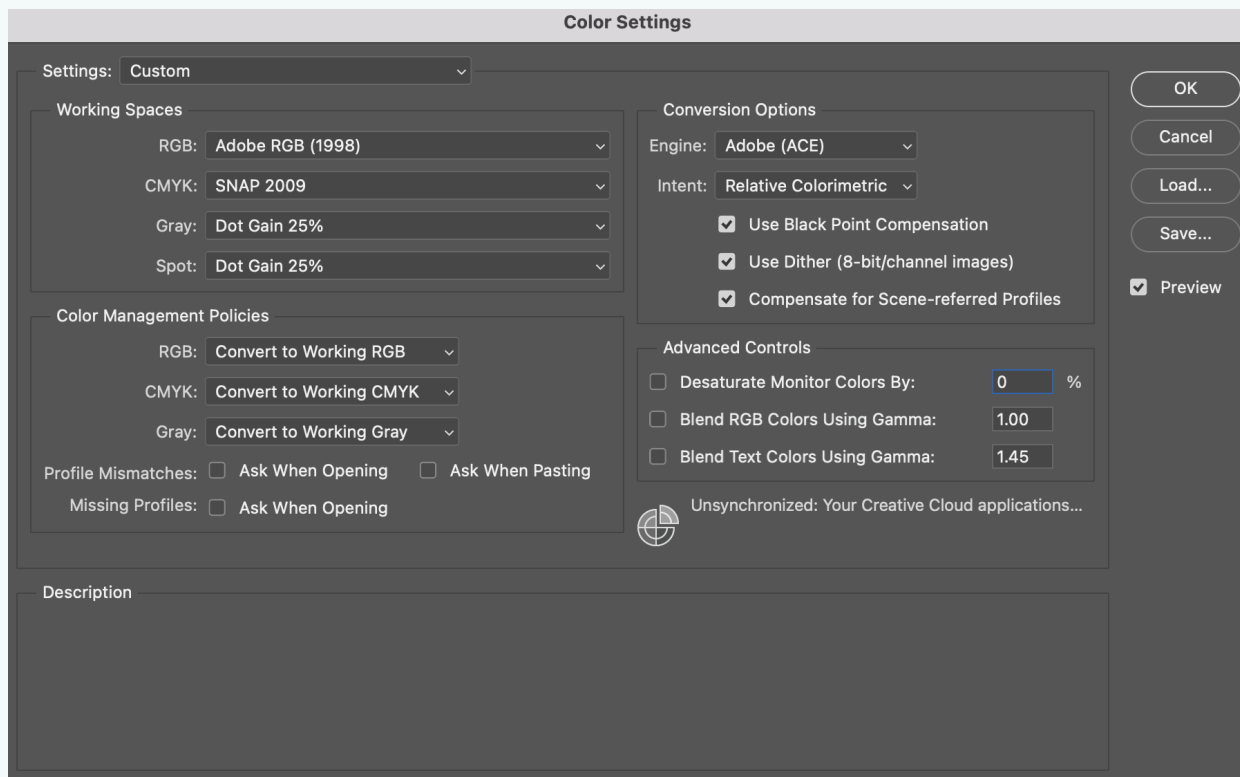
1. Open Photoshop

2. Click **EDIT**

3. Select **COLOR SETTINGS**



4. Change all values to mimic the values below. Then click **OK**.  
(some users may need to click **MORE OPTIONS** in the color settings window)



## Working Spaces

RGB: Adobe RGB (1998)  
CMYK: SNAP 2009  
Gray: Dot Gain 25%  
Spot: Dot Gain 25%

## Color Management Policies

RGB: Convert to Working RGB  
CMYK: Convert to Working CMYK  
Gray: Convert to Working Gray  
Profile Mismatches/Missing Profiles: leave unchecked

## Conversion Options

Engine: Adobe (ACE)  
Intent: Relative Colormatic  
✓ Use Black Point Compensation  
✓ Use Dither (8-bit/channel images)  
✓ Compensate for Scene-referred Profiles

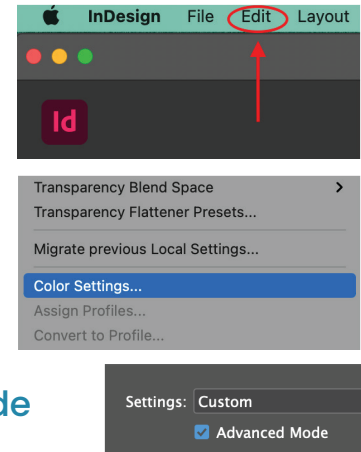
## ADOBE INDESIGN APPLICATION SETTINGS

1. Open InDesign

2. Click **EDIT**

3. Select **COLOR SETTINGS**

4. Change setting to **CUSTOM** and check  **Advance Mode**



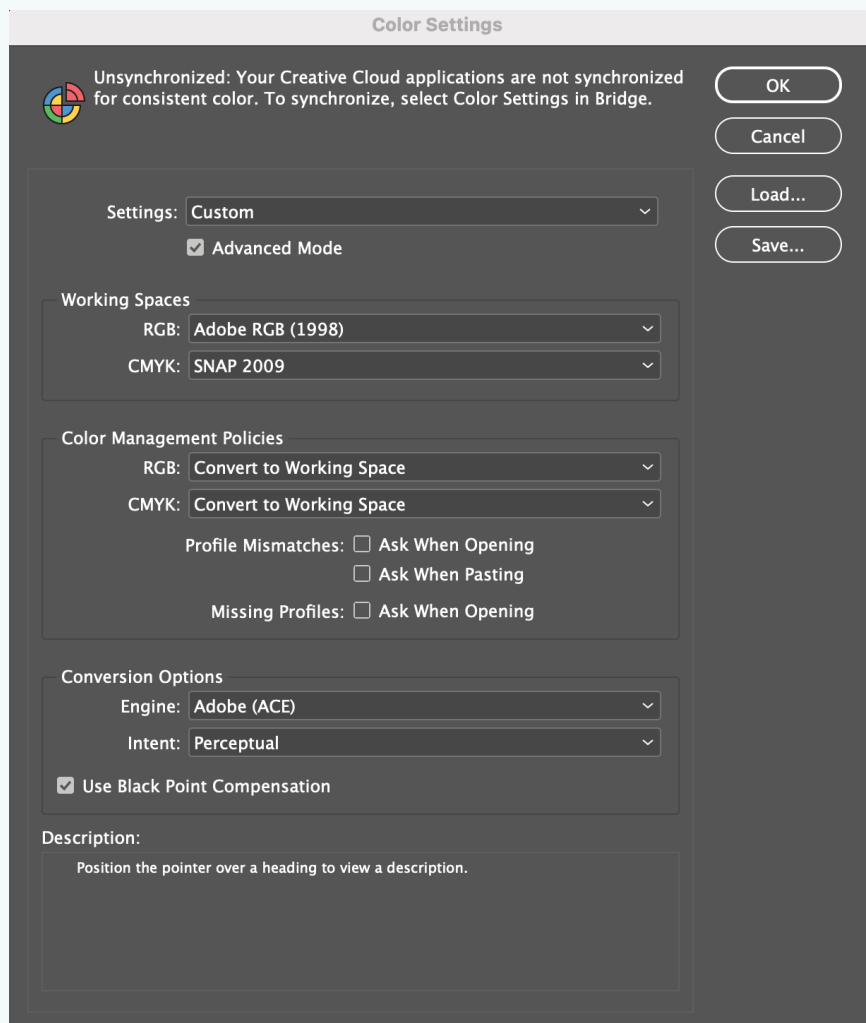
5. Change all values to mimic the values below. Then click **OK**.

## SFNM.JOBOPTIONS INSTALL

1. Open InDesign
2. Click **FILE > EXPORT > ADOBE PDF PRESETS > DEFINE**
3. Click **LOAD**, select the **SFNM.joboptions** file, then click **DONE**

## CREATING PAGES

1. Open InDesign
2. Click **FILE > EXPORT**
3. Under **ADOBE PDF PRESETS**, select **SFNM**
4. Select the correct page, click **EXPORT**

**VERY IMPORTANT:** Pages must be done one by one, as stated in the FTP Package.

## A FEW THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

- Your total ink coverage (TAC) needs to be less than or equal to 240%. Anything above 240% will lead to over saturation, blurriness, and washed out or muddy paper.
- Rules that are 4pts or smaller should be made up of 100% Black (K) only.
- The following font styles should be 100% Black (K) only to prevent blurriness:

Sans-Serif fonts, 7pts or smaller

Serif fonts, 12 pts or smaller

fine/light/thin Serif fonts, 14 pts or smaller

- **Type smaller than 12 pts should not be reversed out of a 4-color background.**
- Type smaller than 10 points should NEVER be reversed.
- Reversed type should not be placed on any background with a TAC of 45% or less.
- Black type and graphics need to be **100% Black ONLY**. We will send files back if any black is made up of 2 or more process colors.
- Screen values above 85% will generally produce a solid color on paper.
- Screen values below 5% will generally not visibly print.

Once these are put in place, the next step is to utilize the correct toning procedures for newspaper output, described in the PDF supplied in your email:
